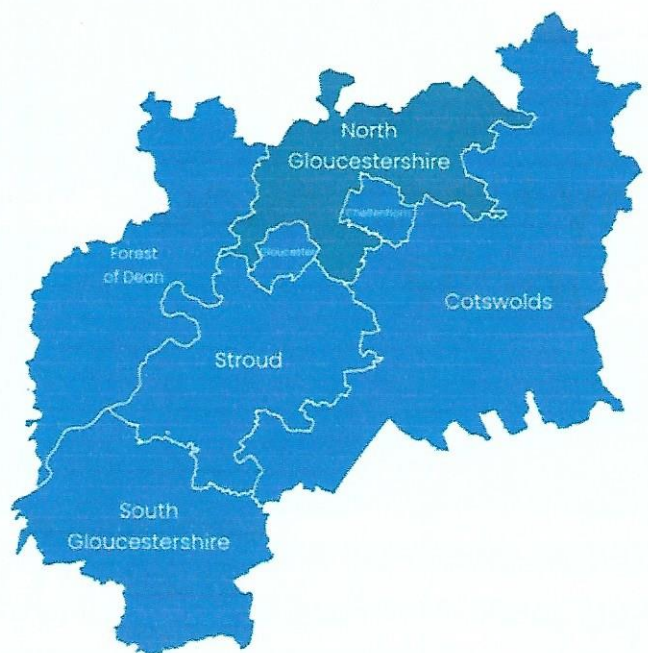
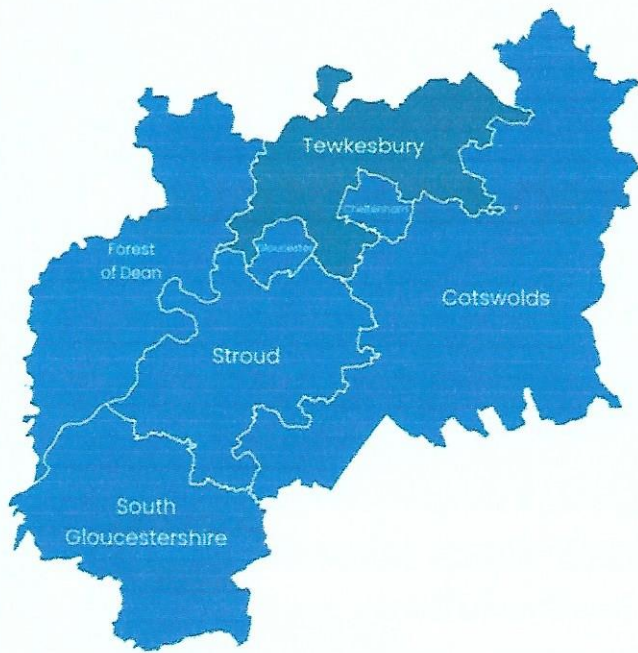


Why North Gloucestershire Borough Council?

The council has chosen North Gloucestershire Borough Council as the preferred option for its new name, as it responds to the issues associated with our current name and offers several advantages.

- It provides **immediate geographic context** and could help to raise the borough's profile regionally and nationally.
- It has a **strong brand appeal** that could benefit economic development and tourism, and help to attract investment.
- It **avoids prioritising one town (Tewkesbury) over others** within the borough, promoting a more inclusive identity.
- It **responds to concerns from businesses** and puts the borough on the map. A stronger identity would support a wider recruitment pool for both the council and local businesses.
